Camp Incentive Grants

All Federation families are eligible for **Camp Incentive Grants of \$300** per camper to pay the initial camp registration deposit. Additional camp scholarships beyond the incentive grants are based on need and require an application submission. All campers who receive Federation support (whether grant or scholarship) are expected to participate in a *tzedakah* activity in support of the Jewish community. 
