#### Possible Temple Bulletin Changes - WE NEED YOUR INPUT!

The weekly Lincoln Jewish Community announcements now include both South Street Temple and Tifereth Israel information, which we distribute only by email. Since so much weekly information is repeated in the current monthly Bulletin, the Board is considering whether to continue the Bulletin as is or make some changes in content or schedule. Among the options being considered are:

- Transition from a monthly to a quarterly schedule, based on prominent Jewish holiday seasons (Passover, Shavuot, High Holy Days, Hanukkah)
- Limit content to non-weekly items, while retaining the regular "From the Rabbi's Study" column, along with life cycle notifications, acknowledgments, and calendar
- Phase out the monthly bulletin as a separate publication and provide hard-copy summaries of the weekly newsletters by mail to those who wish tro receive them.
